I have been cautious of pursuing any friendships of anybody in prison. I am from a law enforcement background having worked in probation for years and I have a son who is a police detective. This makes me very skeptical of dealing with prisoners.

I have come to know PF Lazor through letter writing and many visits. I have tried to help him with situations he could not deal with because of being incarcerated. He is a very straight forward person who tries very hard to live a righteous life. He is very intelligent and as all can see, does not fit your typical "stereotype" mold for a prisoner. I personally believe his crime was self-defense, but in spite of that, 22 years in prison for 2nd degree murder even if he was guilty, is long enough!

PF Lazor has many friends who have been fighting for his release for many years. He has no previous record before this crime. He was and is a very talented person who I believe can contribute much to this world. Please grant him parole.
