Mr. Lazor and I met as a result of my posting a business card on a bulletin board in a Sunnyvalle restaurant. My card listed my profession as product design and new product developement. Mr. Lazor's interest in inventing and product developement caused him to contact me as he had a particular project in mind and was looking for design assistance. (The dates of this interaction and subsequent interactions are recorded in the project workbook which was in his possesion at the time he was arrested).

During the course of our interaction, I was impressed by Mr.Lazor for a number of reasons:

- 1. He was apparently very resourseful in many ways and appeared to be a "doer",
- 2.He seemed willing to share very fairly the potential profits should our joint effort prove to be fruitful—he did this volentarily and without my feeling the need to bargin with him to protect my interest,
- 3. His interests transcended the normal mundane business of making a living and simply getting by in the world. In conversations incidental to our business meetings, we talked of broad topics such as the value of a material versis spiritual approach to living. My impression was that he basically agreed that while getting ahead materially was very important, the most valuable things in life have to do with gaining as high a consciousness as possible and living in a clean and harmoneous way with the remainder of the universe.
- 4.He exhibited the ability to understand technical aspects of our project in which he had no training. He seemed to grasp the subtler points easily and be able to project them to possible consequences given various starting situations.
- 5.He was <u>always</u> very conscientious about keeping appointments promptly and considerate in letting me know if it was necessary to change his plans.

Although I could not say I got to know him well during our infrequent meetings, I did form an impression that Mr. Lazor was a person with whom I might eventually become a friend. I should add that I am very cautious of elevating aquantances to the level of friends.
