He is generous with his time and energy, often spending hours, days or even weeks to make special gifts for those he loves. My three daughters, aged 11, 7 and 4, visit PF in prison frequently. He has established a very nurturing relationship with the girls, inspiring them to broaden their horizons but also to find happiness in little ways.

Despite his incarceration, PF's incredible strength of self has allowed him to retain the truly good qualities that have endeared him to countless number of people whose lives he has touched in a meaningful way. PF's prison songs tell a story of great suffering, but are the work of a man with an indomitable spirit. As someone who interacts with prisoners on an almost daily basis, through my work, I can objectively but vehemently state that PF Lazor is not a criminal, and has broken no laws of man or God. He deserves his chance to prove this to a jury.
