AFFIDAVIT OF SHIRLEY R. LEWIS

I, Shirley R. Lewis, declare that the following statements are true and correct, based on my personal observation, knowledge and interactions with PF Lazor.

I, Shirley R. Lewis, of 370 West Olive Avenue #2, Sunnyvale, CA 94086, have been a resident of Sunnyvale almost 20 years. I am a housewife, now almost 70 years of age.

I learned of PF Lazor in this way. During the time that I was serving as Program Chairman for the Sunnyvale Republican Women, Federated, we had one speaker who would come free, provided the Club arranged other meetings for him. One of the meetings I set up was with Toastmasters, the Lockheed club. The young man who arranged meetings for them was Tim Takahashi. During our discussions he mentioned PF Lazor. (Mr. Takahashi has since left Lockheed.) So PF and I became pen-pals, for approximately three years now.

I do not believe it is possible to demonstrate one kind of character while writing and have another kind of character face to face. Just as you soon discover frauds in personal dealings, so you can soon determine any discrepancies in personal correspondence.

During our friendship he has always shown himself to be kind, patient, long-suffering. Although I believe he suffered some kind of rough treatment in prison, he never mentioned it except when I referred to a visit from my daughter who is an audiologist. Then he mentioned his ear trouble. I have also heard from my friend Charles Walker, the Chaplain for the Santa Clara County facilities, that PF is well known to the chaplain at Vacaville, who regards him as helpful and interested in the services offered there.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
