After considerable study of his

Prison Punishment Time.

Mr Lagon has not taken up
with nor been accepted by the rough
Tough group of Prison People.

Rather - he has been more of
a student and written in defense of
himself for freedom, not entirely, but
somewhat alone - often under difficult
circumstances.

I see no problem with Mr Lagon
being able to support himself in a
productive lively way.

He is prepared to compete on the outside
with his many Talents and the desire to
use them.
