- As the prophets have spoken not one word has been broken, telling centuries in advance of things today.
 No one can run from this certainty as pronounced, it's something that had to be; "prepare to meet your maker"

 as they say.
- As the prophets have spoken our world's come apart and's broken. But many can't see the writing on the wall. As the climax approaches near the heart of the scoffer coaches fear from the sidelines, redlined and still blind to it all.

BRIDGE: "We're in the end of time,"
the wise and the courageous say,
"the system has run out of time today."
Scorned and mocked in a world that's rocked
where common sense everywhere is blocked
the just and righteous knocked — out of the way.

3. As the prophets have said it most of the world still doesn't get it! Some will live to regret it — some won't know. As the curtain closes at the ending scenes many still so dazed don't know what it means, until they announce again, it's the end of the show.
